Introduction

Sex. Over 40 Million women in the United States alone say “They love their husbands but do not enjoy sex.” *Relationship Resources can show you how to enjoy your love making every time by a proven, easy to learn method.* Furthermore, those 40 million husbands will finally understand exactly why their wives don’t enjoy sex and how by using the revolutionary Judge Method, their wives will not only enjoy sex every time, but will actually want it increasingly often.

- **The Problem**

For women, the act of sex is an act of physical and emotional intimacy. However, even when emotional intimacy is present, the physical act represents (for the most part) a total lack of physical release. This is because the *internal orgasm is a learned release* and cannot be achieved easily during the usually practiced methods of intercourse.

For most men, the act of sex is an act of individualistic pleasure and pure physical release. Even when a man is emotionally involved with a woman, it only adds an extra dimension to the physical act of intercourse. Most men have never been taught how to satisfy a woman, and are completely baffled when women who love them don’t desire intercourse. The act of sex is a total bummer for most women and becomes a chore as they feel no definitive internal orgasmic release and in fact are left with the aftermath (i.e. vasocongestion) that can linger for up to three hours. This is not the man’s nor the women’s fault, as neither yet knows the key that unlocks the door to a woman’s satisfaction.

To a woman, sex is of the ultimate emotional importance. For a man, sex is of no more emotional importance than eating a good meal.

- **The Solution**

It is a *specific physical method* that can be practiced and learned with a little effort. Once women have learned this tissue-memory response, sex becomes extremely pleasurable and they will look forward to the physical release as much as men do. The only sure way to know that a woman has experienced this incredible internal orgasm during or immediately after intercourse is when she bursts into uncontrollable tears.

There is not a man alive who does not want to know the ultimate answer to pleasing a woman.

This internal orgasm is very seldom achieved during the traditional ways in which men and women commonly engage in intercourse. This is because very specific physical motions have to be executed in the vagina. To continually reproduce this internal orgasm requires knowledge of the location & response of the female reproductive system. The *Judge Method* is specifically designed to impart this knowledge. The penis, marvelous organ though it is, is solely engaged in its own voluptuous sensations being transmitted to the brain, *with ejaculation being its final hurrah*. It has no tactile memory, can’t transmit what is happening in the vagina, and where and at what stage the woman’s orgasmic response, if any, is beginning or ending. It must be remembered that *98% of women fake their purported orgasm* because they:

1. Don't know what it is
2. Have never had one
3. Wouldn't know what it was if they had had one
4. Feel that they are the only ones in the world who aren't having one
5. Want to make their partners feel like they are satisfying their needs

- **Anatomy**

This is a brief introduction to the female and male reproductive organs that are commonly engaged in the act of intercourse. This is essential to understand the Judge Method. The penis will be discussed first. It is composed of corpora cavernosa tissue, which in Latin means "cavernous bodies" that suffuse or engorge with blood upon a signal from the brain, which also activates the prostate gland. This system is designed for procreation and an intensely pleasurable orgasmic release. This can occur very quickly, an average being two to seven minutes, and is solely designed as a delivery system of sperm for purposes of procreation. The biological imperative of this delivery system was to ensure the survival of the species, and thus men are programmed biologically and physiologically speaking to impregnate everything that they can ***"catch and club."*** Far from being lost in the myths of time, this domineering force is in effect today and no amount of cultural programming has ever altered this primal urge. ***The ability for a man to stay faithful to one woman all his life is for all intents and purposes, a biological and physical rarity.*** A small percentage of men however, seem to be able to overcome these tendencies.

- **Commentary**

For women, the act of intercourse, procreatively speaking, is an act of lying there, ***"being a receptacle for sperm."*** Whether or not nature ever intended for women to enjoy this is a moot point. Culturally however, and only in the last few decades, has sex become an ***"equal opportunity"*** act. When there were murmurings of complaint about the inadequacy of the ***"act"*** from a woman's perspective, the courageous sex researchers Masters & Johnson set out to find if indeed there was an internal orgasm for women. They postulated that women reach a plateau of vasocongestion and then finished only with two words: ***"Orgasm Occurs."*** How and what this orgasm was, what a woman felt and how would she know when she had one was all left to the nebulous area of the imagination. Dr. David Reuben, in his book, *Everything You've Always Wanted to Know About Sex But Were Afraid to Ask*, which by itself has sold well over 100 million copies, stated that ***"The only thing that stands between any woman and an unlimited number of orgasmic experiences is about two pounds of tissue - the brain. The decision to have a sexual climax is not made in the vagina - it occurs at the other end of the body."*** Moreover, Freud theorized that anything less than the vaginal orgasm in women is infantile in nature. Ann Landers conducted a famous survey of her female readers in which she posed this question: ***"Would you rather be kissed and cuddled by your significant other or "do it."*** The "it," of course, being the act of sex. The response was an overwhelming 95% saying that they would ***rather be kissed and cuddled.*** The polls are even more startling today as women are learning to express themselves more vocally and frequently. The results from a year 2000 study which aired on the Oprah Winfrey Show found that an astounding 98% of women who have

routine gynecological exams have one or more concerns about sex, and of those, 87% said that the thing that *bothered them the most was their lack of interest or enjoyment in the sex act.*

It's obvious in the natural order of things, that as humans developed, we invented the concept of enjoying the procreative process. To say that women have not enjoyed lying there being a receptacle beyond their years of puberty is putting it mildly. Everybody has searched for the answer, and it turns out to be relatively simple if one analyzes the different procreative functions of men and women. Women's dissatisfaction with their role in this most beautiful and intimate of all acts between husbands and wives, or significant others, has been part and parcel of a unanimous underground. It is only in today's climate that women feel free to express this dissatisfaction openly and without fear of condemnation. Dr. John Gray has explored the subject further, and has written several very illuminating books, including *Men are from Mars, Women are from Venus*, and *Mars and Venus in the Bedroom*, which as a series, has sold over 15 million copies since 1992 in the U.S. alone. However, these books only illuminate the subject of communication between men and women, sexual and otherwise.

Women need to know that the answer to their prayers, their distress, and their total dissatisfaction with the sexual act is a simple understanding of their procreative anatomy and their role in the original purposes of *"the act."* They will be delighted to find that with a little practice and perseverance, their orgasmic responses will be far more frequent, pleasurable and totally fulfilling. They will no longer feel like they are getting the short end of the...er, stick.
